**WHEREAS**, Every year since 1899, Harvard University has awarded a scholarship to its most promising sophomore student, the Jacob Wendell Scholarship; and

**WHEREAS**, Out of nearly one hundred students nominated, eighteen year old Jonathan D. Farley was chosen as this year's distinguished recipient of the Wendell Scholarship; he was selected by a faculty committee after a scrutinous review of his qualifications; and

**WHEREAS**, Jonathan is a Brockport High School graduate and the first ever Black student to receive the award since its inception ninety years ago; and

**WHEREAS**, This Legislative Body is delighted to join with his very proud parents, Rawle Farley, an economics professor at SUNY Brockport and a former economic development expert for the United Nations, his mother, Ena Farley, chairwoman of SUNY Brockport's Department of African and African-American Studies, and his three brothers Anthony, Felipe and Christopher, each of whom is a graduate of Harvard and/or the Harvard Law School, in extending its most heartfelt congratulations to Jonathan D. Farley, Harvard '91; and

**WHEREAS**, Jonathan, who plans a career in academics teaching mathematics at the college level, is a superlative example of the shining spirit of youth and determination so vital in the world today; and

**WHEREAS**, He is a joyous source of unending enthusiasm, dedicated to his educational pursuits, exploring his abilities, improving his own understanding of his chosen field, and devoted to his parents and his brothers; and
